- SPAN 1411 Elementary Spanish** 4.3.4
A study of pronunciation, the fundamentals of grammar, vocabulary building through reading on topics of specific situations and conversation on related subject matter. Drills in pronunciation and points of grammar are repeated in taped material. Fee charged.
- SPAN 1412 Elementary Spanish** 4.3.4
A continuation of SPAN 1411. Fee charged. Prerequisite: SPAN 1411 or equivalent.
- SPAN 2311 Intermediate Spanish** 3.3.2
An intensive and concise review of phonetics and grammar, with dialogues for comprehension and conversation, with introduction to Hispanic culture. Fee charged. Prerequisites: two years of high school Spanish or SPAN 1412. Core Curriculum satisfied for Humanities.
- SPAN 2312 Intermediate Spanish** 3.3.2
Continuation of SPAN 2311 with some outside readings. Fee charged. Prerequisite: SPAN 2311 or consent of instructor. Core Curriculum satisfied for Humanities.
