Head Coach
Sylvester Jallah

Sylvester Jallah is in his second year heading the men's and women's soccer programs, bringing experience as both coach and player. Coach Jallah came to PJC after serving as the assistant men's soccer coach at the University of Texas - Tyler for three years. At Tyler the team was runner-up in the American Southwest Conference. The program there was also recognized as an NSCAA academic program for two consecutive years. Prior to UT Tyler, Jallah was soccer coach at Killeen High School in Killeen, Texas where he helped lead the Kangaroos to a 65-15-5 overall record from 2007 to 2013. Killeen made the playoffs for four straight seasons, from 2008 to 2011, with Jallah picking up District Coach of the Year honors in 2008, 2009, 2010, and 2011 for Class 5A, Region 3. His team made history for the school with five consecutive playoff runs. Jallah played for the University of Mary Hardin-Baylor in the American Southwest Conference, and served as assistant there from 2006 to 2007. He has also played soccer with the Austin Aztecs, the Olympic Development Program in Bitburg, Germany and FC Bamberg.

Zach Zellmer

Coach Zach Zellmer is in his first season at PJC as assistant coach of the men's soccer program - his first college-level coaching job. Zellmer comes to PJC after graduating from Dallas Christian College in 2017 with a bachelor's degree, as well as on the soccer team where he was team captain in 2014. While he was on the team, the Crusaders were Southwest Regional Champions, placing 4th at the National Collegiate Athletic Association Championships in 2016. Zellmer was named the college's Defensive Player of the Year. The team made the Association of Christian College Athletics National Tournament in 2014 and was NCCAA Regional Champion in 2015. Prior to Dallas Christian College Coach Zach played at Central Christian College in McPherson, Kansas from 2010-2011. Zellmer also played soccer with the DFW Tornados PDL team, other teams in the DFW area, all over the United States, as well as playing overseas in Australia.
