# CITATION AT A GLANCE

## SHORT WORK FROM A WEB SITE (MLA)

- 3 pts 1. *Author(s) [If unknown, begin citation with title in quotations.]*
- 3 pts 2. *Title of short work*
- 3 pts 3. *Title of Web site*
- 3 pts 4. *Sponsor of the Web site*
- 3 pts 5. *Update date ["n.d." if there is no date]*
- 3 pts 6. *Medium*
- 3 pts 7. *Date of Access*

Example:

Haller, Chris. "Teens, Video Games and Civics." *Public Agenda*. Public Agenda. n.d.. Web. 8 Feb. 2010.

# CITATION AT A GLANCE

## E-BOOK

Optional Source – Cite it as you would a short work from a Web site.

- 3 pts 1. *Author's name*
- 3 pts 2. *Title of work (Italicized)*
- 3 pts 3. *Editor's name [or compiler, translator, etc.] if given*
- 3 pts 4. *Publication information for original print version*
- 3 pts 5. *Electronic publication information*
- 3 pts 6. *Medium*
- 3 pts 7. *Date of Access*

Example:

Palmer, Edward L., and Brian M. Young. *The Faces of Television Media: Teaching, Violence, Selling to Children*. Lawrence Erlbaum Associates, Inc., 2003. *eBook Collection (EBSCOhost)*. Web. 29 Sept. 2011.
