SHORT WORK FROM A WEB SITE (APA)

- 4 pts 1. *Author(s)* [If unknown, begin citation with title in quotations.]
- 4 pts 2. *Date of publication or most recent update*
- 4 pts 3. *Title of document on Web site*
- 4 pts 4. *Title of the Web site or section of site*
- 4 pts 5. *DOI or URL of document*
